



DATA PROTECTION AND PRIVACY NOTICE.

Calzaturificio S.C.A.R.P.A. S.p.a., Via E. Fermi 1, 31011 Asolo (TV), email: privacy@scarpa.net, as owner of the personal data (hereinafter referred to as the "Data Controller"), has issued this notice for the Data Subject in respect of the Italian and European legislation on the protection of personal data. This notice complements the browsing policy of our website, in order to illustrate to the User how the Company will specifically process the data entered in this contact form. Purposes and Legal Grounds of the Processing

Calzaturificio S.C.A.R.P.A. S.p.A. will not carry out marketing activities based on the information entered in this form. The Data Controller processes the personal data disclosed through this form only to respond to requests received. For example, requests for information on products or services (including sending brochures, catalogues and/or other company information material), to obtain a quote, etc. Therefore, consent is not required because this processing is necessary to respond to such requests.

Data Retention Period

If information is required, the data will be processed for the time necessary to reply. However, if a quote is required, the data will be processed for a maximum time equal to twenty-four months from the validity period of the proposal, notwithstanding further retention for the time necessary for the definition (however this is reached) of any disputes that may arise.

Nature of the Provision of Data and Consequences of any Refusal

The provision of data is strictly related to the use of the contact form and is therefore necessary to forward the request for information. Failure to communicate in this manner, in fact, makes it impossible to provide the information requested.

Scope of Reporting of Data and Categories of Recipients

The Data Controller will not disclose any data, but this is subject to disclosure to internal personnel authorised to process data according to their respective duties. The same applies to professionals or service companies and to public and private bodies, also following inspections and checks. These recipients, if they are required to process data on behalf of the Data Controller, will be appointed data processors under a specific contract or by another legal means.

Transfer of Data to a Third Country and/or an International Organization

Your personal data will not be transferred to any third country outside the EU or to international organizations.

Rights of Data Subjects

It is the Data Subject's right to request that the Data Controller access his/her personal data and rectify it where inaccurate, delete it or limit its processing where certain conditions are met, as well as obtain the portability of any data personally sent.
